DPHS has a large and expanding program of collaborative and internal research. The position will involve highly collaborative interactions within DPHS and within the College of Medicine. There will be emphasis on projects developed under the direction of College of Medicine faculty members, but the position also involves working within other areas of clinical and basic research. The candidate will also assist in teaching an introductory statistics course.

Candidates should be able to work independently, have experience and ability in computer-oriented data analysis and statistical programming, and excellent oral and written communication skills.
